The Round-Up is an annual talent production presented by the students of Will Rogers High School under the sponsorship of a student board. It is entirely an extra-curricular project, the purpose of which is to allow students who have fine arts talents to make a contribution to the school life and to increase their interest in and loyalty for the school. It is an educational project in that students develop their creative talents and at the same time grow in their ability to get along with others and to submerge their own desires for the benefit of the whole.

Every effort is made to keep this activity a democratic one. Any interested student is entitled to apply for the Round-Up Board, members of which are finally chosen on the basis of their ability to contribute to the planning and production of the show. Early in the fall a theme is chosen by the Board, and all students in the school are eligible to plan and try out for numbers they think will be suitable. The students on the Board are the sole judges of what acts are chosen for the production. After tryouts, the students and teachers in the several departments work together to weave the numbers chosen into the theme and to produce a unified show.

Thus, we present to you another Round-Up, the result of a democratic process, of group planning and group action—the best system we know.
